ADIRONDACK PARK AGENCY FAILED THE PUBLIC'S TRUST

OUR 120 YEAR OLD ADIRONDACK PARK ... IS IN PERIL.



Governor Andrew Cuomo's Adirondack Park Agency recently voted 10-1 to approve the Adirondack Club and Resort project – one of the largest park subdivisions in APA history.

The project's Public Hearing showed that:

- ACR's housing and roads will fragment 4,800 acres of backcountry forest
- Wildlife habitats were not studied
- Alternative ways of developing the site were ignored
- Economic benefits were highly exaggerated
