


THE ADIRONDACK PARK IS AT A CROSSROAD.

NEW YORK STATE GOVERNMENT STRAYS FROM ITS PARK MISSION.



PART 1 OF OUR REPORT IS NOW AVAILABLE. IT EXPLAINS THAT:

- The natural resources of the Park face grave threats, and the Park is not as well protected as is often assumed;
- A pattern of State actions fragments blocks of forest and other habitats which distinguish the Park;
- Incompatible development proceeds with only cursory environmental review;
- Neither APA nor DEC is analyzing Park trends, measuring long-term impacts, or using best scientific practices;
- State government decisions compromise our State Forest Preserve and the integrity of Article XIV;
- Finally, our report recommends a dozen actions to better safeguard and benefit the Park.
