- Strong leadership and a full slate of qualified nominees independent from the DEC, ready to stand up for the State Land Master Plan, Rivers and APA Acts;
- Skills in the law, science and planning;
- Independent, critical thinkers mindful of the statewide interest in conservation of the Park's resources and preservation of its open space character.

The Governor has a list of excellent candidates with the above qualifications willing to serve the APA. Who will he nominate? The NYS Senate should only confirm qualified nominees.
